2012 Scholarship Information

The Iowa Motor Carriers Foundation is a non-profit corporation organized for the purpose of providing educational opportunities to deserving young Iowans. The Foundation's scholarship program is administered by the Iowa Motor Truck Association in Des Moines, Iowa.

Scholarships awarded by the Iowa Motor Carriers Foundation are available to students majoring in any field of study. To be eligible to receive an IMCF scholarship, a student must be a permanent resident of the state of Iowa. The student also must currently be attending or planning to attend any of the following types of educational institutions:

- A community college located in Iowa
- A public or private trade school located in Iowa
- A private college or university located in Iowa
- A public college or university located in Iowa

The **Towing and Recovery Professionals of Iowa Scholarship** was established by an endowment in 2012 from the Towing and Recovery Professionals of Iowa (TRPI). This is a division of the Iowa Motor Truck Association which represents Iowa's towing industry. This scholarship is awarded annually to a student who is either an employee or a family member of an employee working for a TRPI member in good standing.

Selections are based on the applicant's academic record and outside activities as they pertain to school and community citizenship. The scholarships are awarded for the fall semester of the year students apply. It is valid only for that academic year and cannot be held over without the approval of the committee. **(One application per person)**
